Joshua 18:1-3 King James Version (KJV)

- 18:1 And the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of the congregation there. And **the land was subdued** before them.
- 2 And there remained among the children of Israel seven tribes, which had **not yet received (take) their inheritance.**
- 3 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, **How long are ye slack to go to possess the land,** which the Lord God of your fathers hath given you?

Do we have an inheritance?

- **Romans 8:17** and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ....
- **Gal 3:29** And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Promises For Here and Now

- **John 14:12** “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.
- 13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.
- 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

Ask and Receive

- **John 16:23** “And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you.
- 24 Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

How Can this Happen?

- **1 John 5:14** Now this is the **confidence** that we have in Him, that if we **ask anything according to His will**, He hears us.
- 15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

We need to know His Will How? His word!

Abide and ask

- John 16:7 If you **abide** in Me, and **My words abide in you**, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.
- 8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

We don't passively say "your will be done"

We actively pray His will that is revealed!

Example – wisdom

- **James 1:5** If any of you lacks wisdom, let **him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.**
- 6 But let him **ask in faith**, with **no doubting**, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.
- 7 For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;
- 8 he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

The Road Map

- **2 Peter 1:3** ...His divine power has given to us **all things** that pertain to **life and godliness**, through the **knowledge of Him** who called us by glory and virtue,
- 4 by which have been given to us **exceedingly great and precious promises**, that through these you may be **partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

(Knowledge – knowing Him by experience)

(Partakers – partners with God! In the Word of God!)

Road Map

- 5 But also for this very reason, giving all **diligence**, add to your **faith virtue**, to virtue **knowledge**,
- 6 to knowledge **self-control**, to self-control **perseverance**, to perseverance **godliness**,
- 7 to godliness **brotherly kindness**, and to brotherly kindness **love**.
- 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The Road Map

- Diligence - I'm in earnest
- Faith – I choose to believe and ask James 1:5
- Virtue – excellence “manliness”
- Knowledge – understand what I'm doing

Road Map

- Self Control –no complaining TONGUE
- Perseverance –patience – hang in there
- Godliness - producing a holy life – saying and willing what God says
- Brotherly love – care for one another
- Love – Agape – the Love God puts in us

Another Example

- Phil 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Supply –to cause to abound, to furnish or liberally supplied, namely, with what is necessary for subsistence, fill up
